While it's our people that account for the strength of our parish, we recognize that our buildings and campus play a vital role and greatly support our mission and ministry.

INSPIRATION BUILDING

As our parish and schools have continued to grow, our campus has served us well. However, we face substantial needs that now must be tackled more intentionally to meet the requirements of our active community. Several existing structures will undergo demolition, including the Convent Building, Madonna Hall, the rectory and the parish offices. In their place, a combined Parish and Performing Arts Center will be constructed.

During the anticipated 16-month construction schedule, select parish and school facilities will be relocated to modular units, and priest housing will be moved off campus permanently. The new construction will add 29,813 square feet in the same basic footprint of the current buildings. Renovations to our church and school will ensure that our spiritual home is a safer and more

inspiring place to worship and learn. The upgrades will include:



PARISH AND PERFORMING ARTS CENTER

The Performing Arts Center will offer a professionally equipped theater seating 367 guests, with separate classrooms for dance and band, a theater arts classroom, and a media studio. It will provide abundant rehearsal space for our school's performing arts program.

The Parish Center will afford generous space for school, church, and community activities. The Parish Center's main hall will comfortably accommodate 300 dining guests, it will house our elementary school's lunch program, and it will include a kitchen, a serving line, meeting rooms, and dedicated religiouseducation and youth-ministry spaces. This main hall and one of the meeting rooms will be divisible for simultaneous multi-purpose use. The Center will have accessible lavatories, and a community room that will serve as a gathering place after Mass and the entrance to the consolidated parish and school offices. Adjacent to the main hall there will be a small twenty-four-hour Adoration Chapel.

PRIEST HOUSING

Saint Genevieve will purchase—and renovate, as necessary—a property in the neighborhood for priest housing. Budgeted costs were based on houses in the 91402 zip code currently selling for an average of approximately \$265/square foot.

TEMPORARY MODULAR UNITS

During construction, we will displace 8 classrooms and 12 offices that are currently in the former convent building. We will place modular units on our current practice field to accommodate the displaced classrooms and offices. We have made arrangements with El Cariso County Park in Sylmar to use their facilities for our teams' daily practice needs. This will require daily busing of our soccer and football teams for the duration of construction. Due to the inconvenience placed on our athletics program and costs associated with busing, Saint Genevieve will aim to complete construction as quickly as possible.

The current estimated cost to complete all aspects of the plan is \$26 million.
